

Dog policy and commitments of the dog owner

General conditions for dog resort access

- All dogs must be registered and declared at the time of booking or upon arrival.
- Only dogs are allowed on the territory of Chalets Lanaudière and in the units allowed.
- In accommodations (cottages and cabins), \$ 52 plus applicable taxes per stay and a maximum of 2 dogs per unit.
If there is a second dog, the rate is \$26 for the stay, plus applicable taxes.
- When camping, there is no charge for your pet. *One dog only allowed per campsite.*

Rules of conduct for the responsible dog owner

- The animal must be kept on a leash and under the supervision of a person in charge at all times. The leash must be a maximum length of 3 metres.
- Authorized dogs must wear the scarf provided by Chalets Lanaudière when they are outside their accommodation unit.
- If a dog is alone inside a housing unit, it must be caged.
- For safety reasons, dogs exhibiting aggressive behaviour or who barks excessively must leave the area in the company of their owner. No refund will be made due to an expulsion from our site.
- The person responsible for the animal must immediately collect all the excrement from his animal and dispose of it hygienically. Bags provided for this purpose are available at the reception desk.

- Pets are not allowed on furniture, such as beds and couches.
- The animal must remain in the authorized areas at all times. **Dogs are not allowed** on the beaches, at wharf no. 4 in Parc Morgan and in yurts.

Responsibilities of dog owners

- As the owner of a dog, I assume full responsibility for all bodily, material and other damage committed by my dog, at any time and any place in the territory of Chalets Lanaudière and Camp Mariste.
- As responsible for my dog, I agree to pay the costs in the event of material damage caused by the presence of my animal. A pre-authorization of \$ 100 or \$ 250 (depending on the unit rented) as a security deposit may be taken 48 hours before arrival on the credit card and will be released at the end of the stay if no damage has been done.
- I, as the owner of a dog, releases Chalets Lanaudière from any responsibility for any bodily, material or other damage related to the behavior of my animal.

As a responsible owner of a dog, I agree to respect this policy and the rules of conduct for my dog during my stay at Chalets Lanaudière,
