# To help you have an enjoyable outdoor experience, especially during the pandemic, please take a few minutes to plan your trip accordingly and always follow the most recent Public Health instructions:

## During reservation:

- 1. When making your reservation, please provide the number of people you wish to register, medical condition therein (i.e., diabetes, allergies, etc.), age, weight, athletic skills and **each** participant's comfort level with animals. Please, if part of your group will not be participating in your activity but wish to remain on site, booking is mandatory for them as well. (An access fee of 20 \$ is required)
- 2. We have multiple activities to suit your abilities. Our trips can be very rigorous, and challenging to the most experienced athlete as well as calmer and more contemplative. Please inform us so we can choose the ideal package adapted to your fitness level.

### **Clothing and equipment:**

- 1. You should wear clothes that you're not afraid to get dirty or torn, boots for -20° temperature in the winter, hat, gloves or mittens (avoid wearing scarves), sunglasses or ski goggles.
- 2. Wear layered clothing so you can adjust to the weather and the intensity of physical activity.
- 3. Bring your own water bottle, a small backpack and ideally disinfectant gel.

### On the site:

- It is important to arrive on site 15 minutes before your scheduled time (please not too far in advance). If you are going to be late, contact Carole Turcotte (514) 231-7453. Expect the duration of your activity to be shorten if you are late because it could change our programming.
- 2. No other dogs are allowed on the site without having received permission from one of our specalists.
- 3. Children must be supervised by their parent(s) at all times
- 4. Throughout the duration of your visit, it is important to be accompanied by a guide while visiting the animals. Never feed the animals without the permission of a guide.
- 5. To ensure the most efficient use of time management, group **fees should be paid in full by a designated individual.**
